

CONDITION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR APPEARING IN THE EXAMINATION

In order to be eligible to appear in the Competitive Examination, a candidate must satisfy the following conditions, namely:-

01. Minimum Qualification:

- i. Class XII passed from a recognized Board with Diploma in GNM from any recognized Nursing Institute or any higher Nursing Education.
- ii. The Staff Nurse post is applicable to both male and female candidates.
- iii. Candidates not registered with the Sikkim Nursing Council are not eligible to appear in the examination.

02. Age Limit:


The candidates should not be below the age of 18 years and over the age of 40 years as on 31. 03. 2018.

03. Required documents:

- (i) Sikkim Subject Certificate/ Certificate of Identification
- (ii) School Certificates (Class X & XII)
- (iii) School mark – sheet (Class X & XII)
- (iv) Date of Birth proof
- (iv) Valid Employment Card
- (v) Community/ Category Certificates
- (vi) BPL Certificate for candidates issued by DESME
- (vii) Married/ Un – Married Certificates (for women candidates only), as the case may be Married women candidates shall furnish the SSC/ CoI of husband and father both
- (ix) Certificate for differently abled candidates issued from SJEWD
- (x) Valid discharged Certificate if applying under Ex – servicemen (reserved category)
- (x) No Objection Certificate from the concerned HoO/ HoD for in – service candidates
- (xi) SPAE Category Certificate issued/ countersigned by the Sports & Youth Affairs Department
- (xii) Registration Certificate from Sikkim Nursing Council (SNC)

04. Other conditions for appointments:

- (i). The candidates should be conversant in either one of the languages notified by the Government as State languages
- (ii). Should have enough knowledge about the history and affairs of the State
- (iii). The selection shall be made through open competitive examinations from amongst the eligible candidates.
