Applications are invited from eligible local candidates for filling up of 15 (fifteen) **posts of Sub-Inspector on temporary regular basis** in PB-2 of ₹ 9300-34800 plus grade pay of ₹ 3800/- in Sikkim Police, Government of Sikkim.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR APPEARING IN THE EXAMINATION FOR THE POST OF SUB-INSPECTOR IN SIKKIM POLICE:

In order to be eligible, a candidate must possess the following, educational qualification, age and minimum physical standard:

A. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA.

1. *Minimum Educational Qualification* : *Graduation from a recognised University.*
2. *Other Qualifications* : (1) *Should have valid Local Employment Card.*
(2) *Should have communicative skill in English /Hindi, and any one of the local languages.*
3. *Age* : *Should have attained the age of 18 years and should not exceed 25 years as on 01/07/2012. The upper age limit shall be as follows:*
 - i) *S.T. - 30 yrs.*
 - ii) *S.C. - 30 yrs.*
 - iii) *B.L - 30 yrs.*
 - iv) *MBC - 29 yrs.*
 - v) *OBC - 28 yrs.*
 - vi) *Unreserved - 25 yrs.*
 - (vii) *Home Guards - Additional Advantage of 02 years.*

C. SELECTION PROCEDURE

1st Stage: Preliminary Examination as a Screening Test (2 papers)

This examination is meant to serve as a screening test only: **the marks obtained in the Preliminary examination by the candidate who is declared qualified for admission to the Main Examination will not be counted for determining his/her final order of merit.** The number of candidates to be admitted for the main examination will be approximately twelve to fifteen times the total number of vacancies to be filled in for the said posts. Only those candidates who are declared by the Commission to have qualified in the preliminary examination will be eligible for admission to the main examination.

Syllabus for preliminary examination

Paper I – (200 marks/ 2 hrs)

1. Current Events of State, National & International importance.
2. History of India and Indian National Movement.
3. Main features of Indian Constitution.
4. Panchayati Raj (local Self Government)
5. Economic and social development – sustainable development, poverty, demographics main environmental, social, educational, health, rural & urban developmental programmes of Central and State Government.
6. General aspect about law & order and international security.

Paper II -- (200 marks/2 hrs)

1. General Science (class X level)
2. Mathematics (class X level)
3. English (class X level)

Note: The Preliminary Examination shall consist of two papers of 200 marks each. The time limit for each paper shall be of two hours duration. The question will be of multiple choice/objective type.
